

Unit Four Map Quiz: North Africa, Southwest and Central Asia

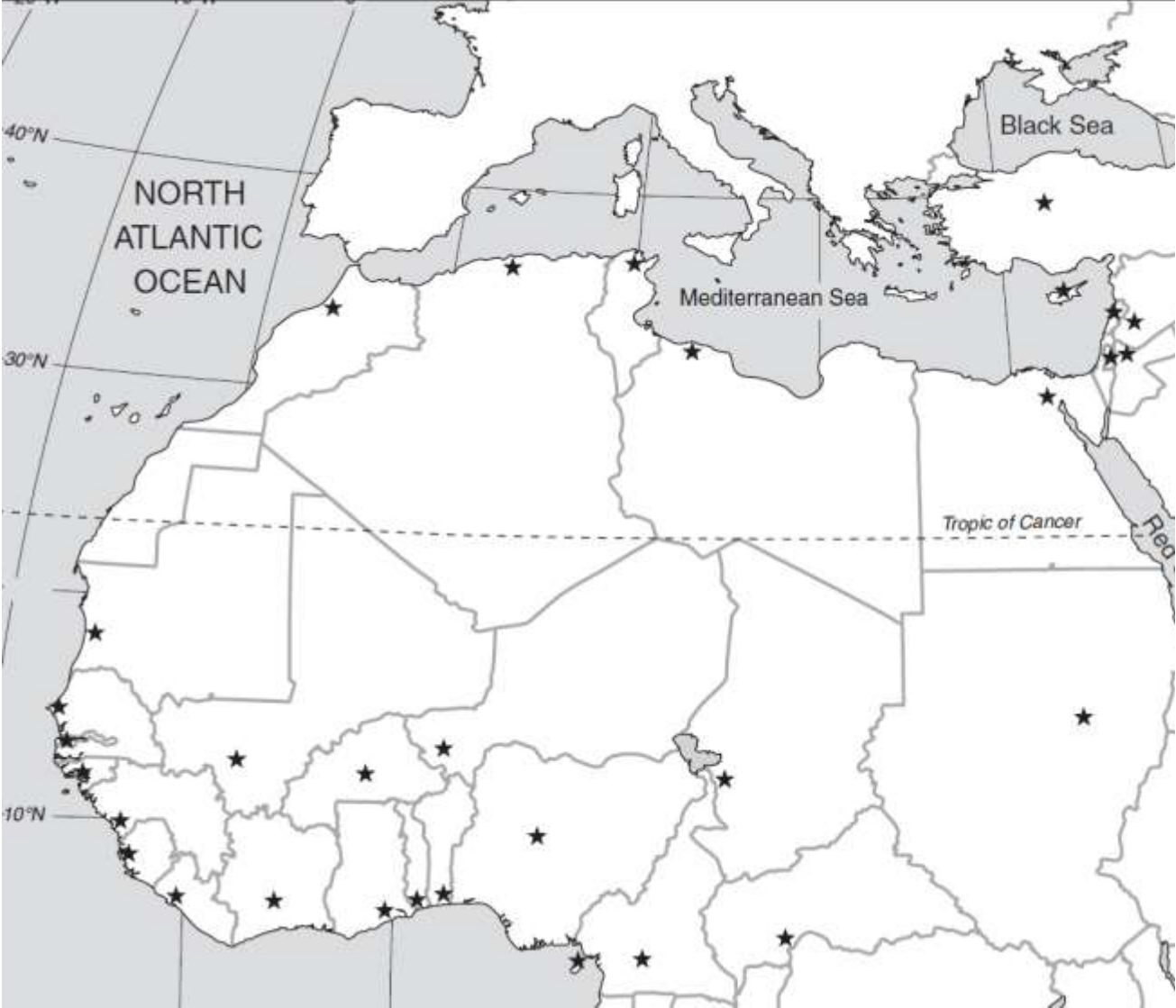
The quiz will be on **Monday, November 10** in class. It will cover the following:

 - Arabian Sea
 - Gulf of Aden
 - Anatolia
 - Zagros Mountains
 - Tigris River
 - Euphrates River
 - Caspian Sea
 - Mesopotamia
 - Strait of Hormuz
 - Strait of Gibraltar

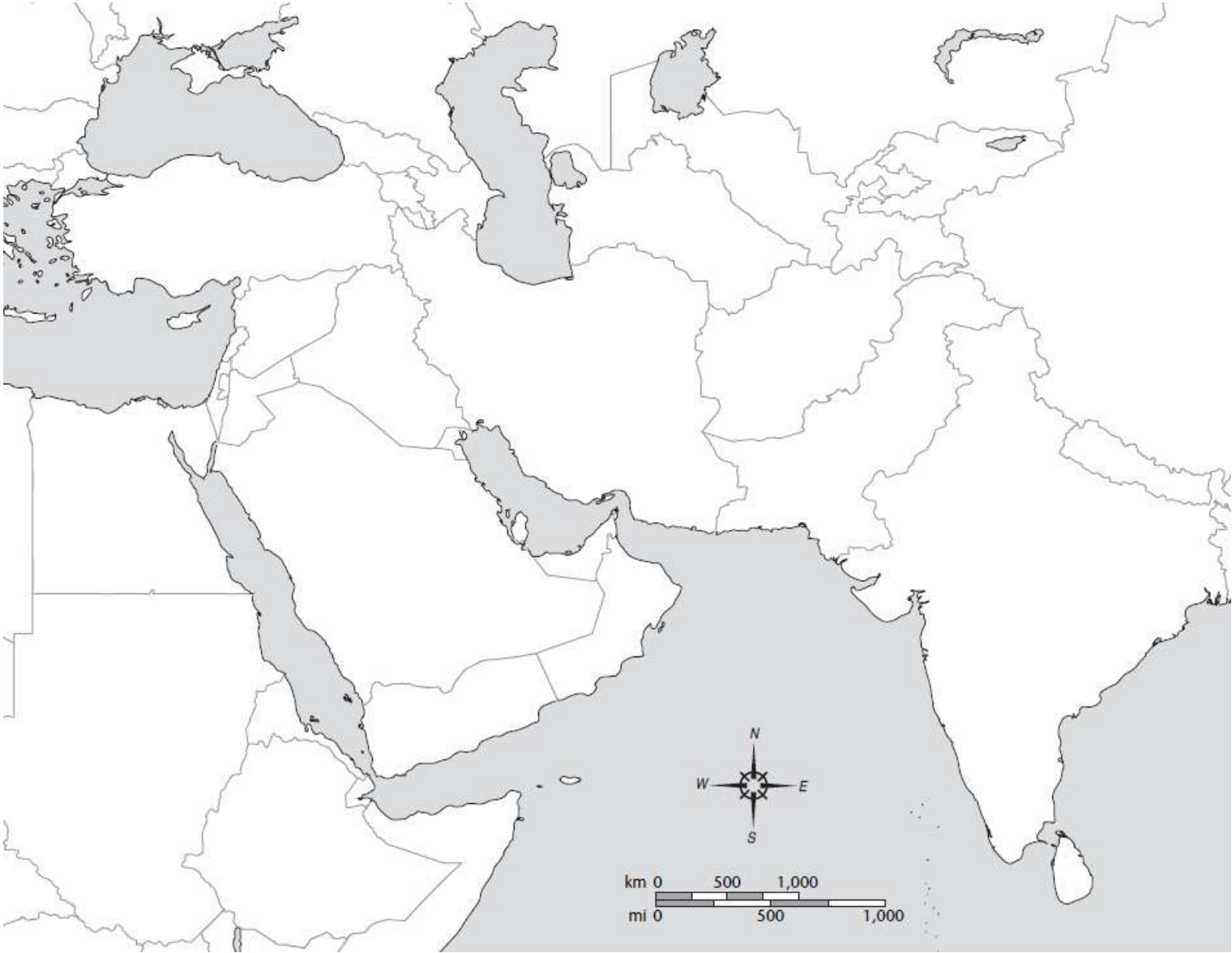
Study Tips
